There has been a buzzing atmosphere of diligence at West Row this week with the children really working very hard at improving their skills.



Year 6 had an online safety lesson this week, which taught them all about how to make sure they used online networking sites safely and how to make sure they weren't involved in cyber-bullying. They learnt some interesting facts which they didn't know before!

Did you know that:

- Children have to be 13 before they should use Facebook, Instagram or YouTube. If the school finds out they are using these sites, we are legally obliged to speak to parents to check they are aware. If we don't feel that parents are monitoring their child's Internet use closely enough to prevent harm coming to them, we are legally obliged to report this to the Safeguarding Team. If any online bullying occurs on such sites and doesn't stop after we have informed parents, we are legally obliged to report it to the Safeguarding Team or Police.
- If a child is proven to be cyber-bullying, the police can take away all their electronic devices.
- If a child feels they have encountered something unpleasant online, that they can press the CEOP button and block that person from contacting them.

Stay Safe
Don't give out your personal information to people / places you don't know.

M
Don't Meet Up
Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Always check with an adult you trust.

A
Accepting Files
Accepting emails, files, pictures or texts from people you don't know can cause problems.

R
Reliable?
Check information before you believe it. Is the person or website telling the truth?

T
Tell Someone
Tell an adult if someone or something makes you feel worried or uncomfortable.
